

Child care and early education providers are responsible for verifying child's birth date on her/his birth certificate.

Child care and early education providers are also responsible for verifying legal residency status. The methods used to verify include but are not limited to:

- A. Child is already receiving funds from other programs or agencies that verify legal status. Examples include TANF cash assistance program, food stamp program, or AHCCCS medical assistance.
 - B. Government documents that indicate lawful presence within the United States e.g. Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services (formerly INS) immigration documents/cards
- AND**
- C. Government documents that indicate U.S. citizenship (i.e. State Bureau of Vital Statistics birth certificates, U.S. Passports, Indian Census Records, Social Security Administration Records)
